design exCHANGE 2023 will highlight emerging architectural and landscape projects designed by regional practitioners. This preview of un-built work and the design process behind built projects gives students and the public a rare glimpse into the studio process and provides a forum for public discourse between the region's academic community and practitioners.

An overview of the design innovation and influence of regional practitioners both large and small, design exCHANGE 2023 offers an exciting preview of future projects to be built regionally, nationally and globally. The closing night reception, with food and live music, is open to students, professionals, and the Seattle design community.

#### ENTRY DETAILS

Projects exhibited must be current "on the boards" unbuilt work. Images documenting the design process and evolution of the project are strongly recommended. These can include but are not limited to iterative studies, ideas explored yet discarded, development of details supporting the core concept, informal sketches and process drawings, etc.

#### ENTRY FORMAT

Each entry is limited to **one project.** Additional projects require additional entries. The PAC reserves the right to refuse a submission if it does not comply with exhibit conditions or is considered inappropriate.

#### ENTRY FEE

\$100 per board (commercial firm)\$50 per board (non-profit firm)

#### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

#### **Presentation Materials:**


Each board and model must present one project. SIZE: Exhibited work will be vertically mounted on 42" x 30" x 1/2" cardboard.

#### <u>CONTENT</u>

- 1. **HEADLINE:** Word or phrase that describes major design idea(s) (not the project name).
- 2. IMAGE(S): Images of the project that convey the design process and evolution of the project: iterative studies, ideas explored yet discarded, development of details supporting the core concept. Informal sketches and process drawings highly encouraged! Image resolution should be high quality to maintain legibility.
- **3. DESCRIPTION:** A description of project goals, constraints, ideas, challenges, and process of development.
- 4. CREDITS: On the front of the board include the project name, location, name of architect/team and each architect's university education (school, name of degree(s) and year of graduation).

#### MODELS

Project models are highly encouraged, including process models! Preferred size is no larger than width of exhibit board, but accommodations may be made for larger models at the discretion of event administrators. Participants must bring in models on the first day of the exhibit and collect models on the last day. Models are displayed at entrant's own risk. Models must be picked up after the exhibit. Please indicate in the "Additional Comments" field of the entry form if you intend to include a model and note the model dimensions.



#### SUBMISSION PROCESS

- 1. Pay entrance fee online at: <u>http://giving.uw.edu/headlines</u> CBE Headlines Exhibit Fund. \$100 per board (commercial firm) and \$50 per board (non-profit firm). All proceeds will go towards the College of Built Environments Department of Architecture Professionals Advisory Council.

- 3. Upload digital entry pdf to Riot no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday May 8, 2023. Save the date for the Closing Reception: Friday May 26, 2023 – 5:30pm, Gould Court as we celebrate another year of this exhibition and toast the work of the architectural work of the Pacific Northwest!
