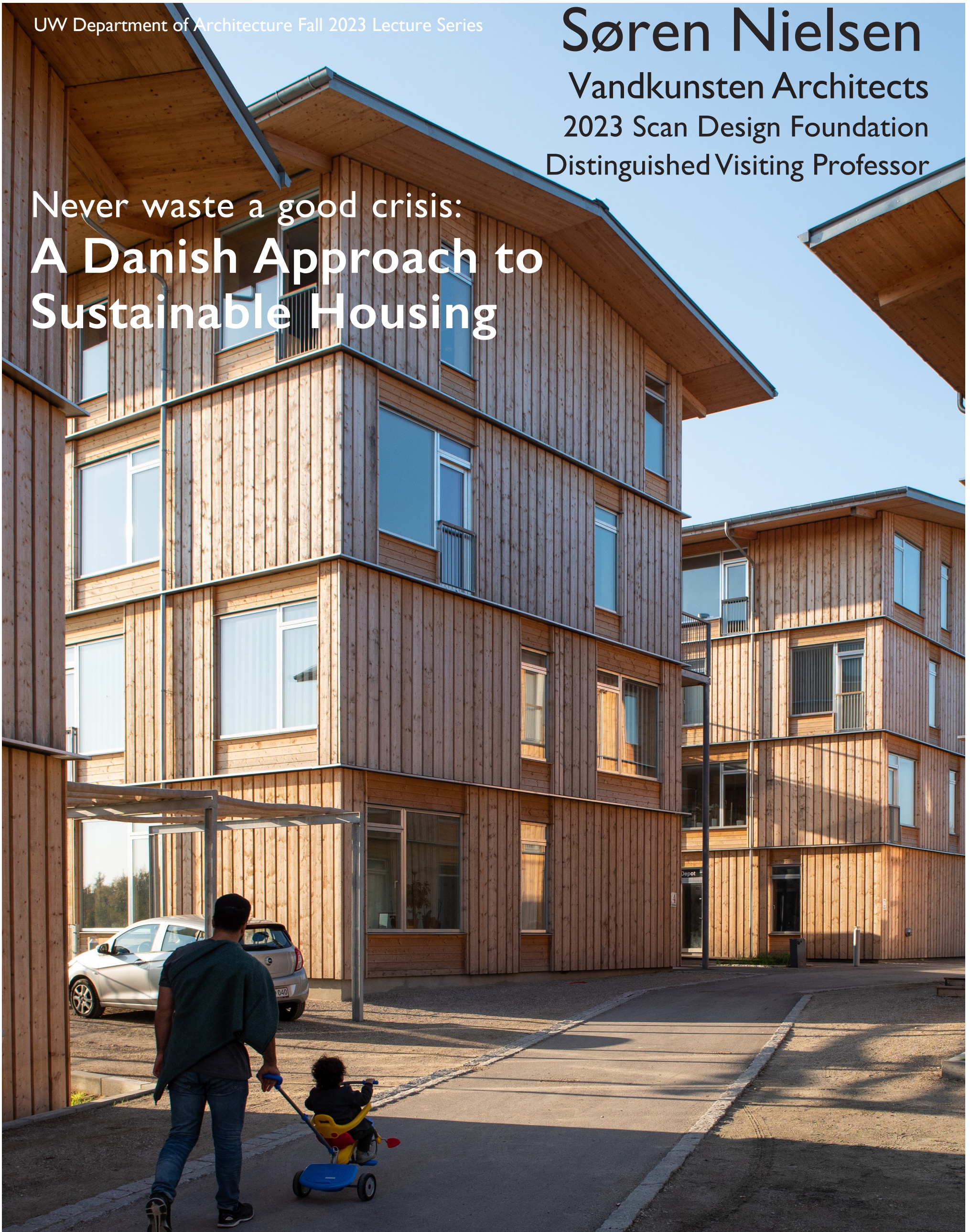

Søren is architect and co-owner of Vandkunsten Architects in Copenhagen, one of the country's leading socially and environmentally engaged offices. Responsible for Vandkunsten's R&D activities, Søren is devoted to design strategies for sustainability, in particular resource protection, building transformation and the social, cultural, and aesthetic aspects of reuse. With 35 years of practice, he has been the leading force behind multiple innovative projects for affordable housing, adaptability, circularity, and the use of biogenic materials.
